

**TOWN OF TEN SLEEP
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
SEPT. 22ND, 2021
5:15 pm**

A special meeting of the Ten Sleep Town council was held at Ten Sleep Town Hall on Sept. 22, 2021. Mayor Beckley called the meeting to order at 5:15 pm.

Councilwoman Sweeney made a motion to accept the minutes from Sept. 7th, 2021 council meeting. Councilman DeWitt 2nd the motion. All were in favor.

Bill Fuchs stated that the Hunters Fest will be held on Oct. 14th from 11 am to 2 pm. It will be on Fir Street in front of Dirty Sally's. Search and Rescue will be blocking the street at the intersection of 2nd and Fir Street. The Town of Ten Sleep will help purchase the meat for this event.

Jared Lyman appeared by zoom for his business permit for Big Trails Off Road, LLC. Councilwoman Sweeney made a motion to approve the permit. Councilwoman Norman 2nd the motion. All were in favor.

Ben Pyle applied for a building permit at 416 3rd Street. This permit would allow Rex Compton to move a mobile home onto the property of Ben Pyle. Maint./Ord. man Harstad had gone down and measured the property and where the home would sit. His measurements do not agree with those of the applicant. They would not meet the need setbacks according to Maint./Ord. man Harstad. Councilwoman Norman stated she would like to have a site inspection. Mayor Beckley stated that they do have 90 days to review if needed. Councilwoman Sweeney made a motion to table this permit for further review of lots and setbacks. Councilwoman Norman 2nd the motion. All were in favor. They will be setting up a date that will work for all interested parties to do a site inspection.

Ilka Lyman applied for a building permit at 425 3rd Street for a 28' x 60' modular home with a Garage. There will be concrete patios (not covered). Councilwoman Norman made a motion to accept the permit. Councilman DeWitt 2nd the motion. All were in favor.

RC Carter dba 1 Cow had a previous building permit in June. He was not present for the meeting and did not have a representative there and that is why it was brought back to the council.


